Washington, DC – HealthHIV, through a five-year cooperative agreement from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), will lead a project to increase HIV awareness among mayors in the United States. This project will facilitate and strengthen collaborative efforts relative to active information exchange, communication, consultation, technical assistance, and problem solving between mayors, local and state health department officials, community-based organizations and other public and private sector organizations regarding HIV prevention.
